DAY 01 - 14.04 - ARRIVAL DAY IN SARAJEVO, BOSNIA-HERZEGOVINA

INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT FROM TORONTO/VANCOUVER TO FRANCFORT FRANCFORT 10H05 / 11H50 SARAJEVO

You will be welcomed by Anne-Marie and transferred to your hotel. Free time in the afternoon and dinner at the hotel. (Hotel PRESIDENT or similar)



DAY 02 - 15.04 - SARAJEVO

Guided walking tour of the historic city. Sarajevo is located on the Miljacka River and was founded in the mid-15th century during the Ottoman era. This rule lasted almost 4 centuries until the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Known as the "Jerusalem of Europe", the city has many Jewish temples, mosques and churches. Sarajevo is a great example of tolerance and respect between different cultures, ethnicities and religions. This incredible diversity was also the reason for such complicated recent history. Sarajevo is a city of extraordinary charm where you will have the impression of finding yourself in another world

especially in the old Ottoman quarter where goldsmiths and craftsmen work on the doorstep of their workshops.

Lunch under your own arrangement and free time in the afternoon. Dinner in a traditional restaurant.

DAY 03 - 16.04 - MOSTAR / NEUM

After breakfast we will be taking the road towards Mostar for approximately 2h30 driving time. We will visit the Old Kujundžiluk district as well as the Old Bridge of Mostar, symbol of the city which is part of the UNESCO world heritage. Nestled in the deep valley of the Neretva River, Mostar was developed in the 15th century as a frontier town of the Ottoman Empire. Almost completely destroyed during the fratricidal war of the 1990's, the Old Bridge district is now rebuilt and symbolically represents international cooperation and coexistence of various cultural communities.



Lunch under your own arrangement and we will continue towards the coast in the afternoon.

3 nights stay at the hotel in Neum. Dinner at hotel. (Hotel NOVA / hotel SUNCE or similar).



Return to Neum. (Border crossing). Dinner at hotel.

DAY 04 - 17.04 - KORCULA / OYSTERS AT STON

Take the road to Orebić on the Pelješac peninsula. (Border crossing). Embark on the private boat for a short crossing to the island of Korčula.

Free time to discover the charm of this Mediterranean town, the birthplace of Marco Polo. After some time we will return to the continent and take the road towards Ston where we will embark on a boat to discover the oyster culture and enjoy a tasting.



DAY 05 - 18.04 - DUBROVNIK

This morning, let's go to **Dubrovnik.** (Border crossing).

This magnificent medieval town was probably created in the first half of the 7th century. The town became the seat of a small republic. Its large merchant fleet ensured great wealth, which is visible today in the town's streets. Walk through this pearl of the Adriatic coast and discover its magnificent monuments. The Franciscan monastery with its old pharmacy, Stradun Street, the church of Saint Blaise, the Column of

Roland, the Sponza Palace, the cathedral, the Rectors Palace and more! Enjoy some free time for lunch and exploration.

Return to Neum. This evening, we will enjoy an unforgettable musical and typical gastronomic dinner.

DAY 06 - 19.04 - OMIS / SPLIT

This morning we are taking the beautiful coastal road to Omiš where an half-hour boat ride will bring us to the riverside restaurant for a meal. After lunch we will continue to Split, the second Croatian city and capital of the Dalmatia region. Guided tour of the historic center and discovery of 1700 years of history enshrined in the walls of the Roman Palace of Emperor Diocletian. Check-in at the hotel in Split for 2 nights.

(ART Hotel or similar). Dinner under your own arrangement.

DAY 07- 20.04 - FREE TIME - ALL DAY IN SPLIT

Breakfast at your hotel.

Explore this fascinating city at your own pace. Lunch and dinner under your own arrangements.







DAY 08 - 21.04 - ETHNO VILLAGE / WINE TASTING / ZADAR

This morning drive to Trogir. Orientation tour of this medieval jewel inscribed on the UNESCO world heritage list.

Free time to enjoy the Mediterranean atmosphere before heading to an ethnographic village for a presentation on the Mediterranean garden and typical products of the region.

We will have lunch here to enjoy "Dalmatian specialties" in a unique atmosphere of an old Dalmatian village. In the afternoon, we will continue towards Zadar and stop for some local wine tasting before arriving in the city. Free time to discover the historic Roman center of Zadar.

Check-in at the hotel (1night) and dinner. (Hotel KOLOVARE or similar).

DAY 09 - 22.04 – NATIONAL PARK OF PLITVICE / OPATIJA

Road to the mountainous region of Lika. Visit and walk in the Plitvice National Park (around 3 hours). Lunch under your own arrangements.

Continue to the seaside resort of Opatija. Check-in at the hotel in Opatija for two nights.

Dinner at the hotel. (Hotel ISTRA or similar).

DAY 10 - 23.04 - EXCURSION IN ISTRIE / MOTOVUN / TRUFFLES LUNCH

Road to central Istria known as the Croatian Tuscany. Visit Motovun, a small medieval town perched on the hill.

We will have lunch in an agritourism village with aromas of truffles since Motovun is surrounded by oak forests which are well known for its abundance of truffles.

Continue to Rovinj, one of the most charming towns with colorful houses. Visit with the guide, free time, then return to Opatija.





DAY 11 - 24.04 – POSTOJNA CAVES / LJUBLJANA

Road to Postojna (1h30) and visit of its spectacular caves. Part of the visit is done by small electric train, and part on foot.

Free time for lunch and continuation to the Slovenian capital Ljubljana. Check-in at the hotel located in the city center.

Free time to explore the charming center located around the Ljubljanica River, overlooked by the medieval castle.

This evening dinner in a restaurant near the hotel. (Hotel IBIS STYLES or similar).

DAY 12 - 25.04 - BLED / ZAGREB

This morning take the road towards Bled, a famous resort located on the edge of the homonymous lake, at the foot of the Alps. Panoramic tour and entry to the castle.

Free time for lunch to stroll around the lake before heading for Zagreb.

Dinner under your own arrangements. Night in Zagreb (Hotel PARK 45 or similar).





DAY 13 - 26.04 - ZAGREB

After breakfast, let's enjoy a guided walking tour of the medieval upper town and the Austro-Hungarian lower town of the capital.

Free time for lunch and personal discoveries.

This evening, farewell dinner in a small typical village.

DAY 14 - 27.04 - DEPART

Breakfast at your hotel

Free time in the morning and transfer to Zagreb airport around 11:00 a.m.
